
ton's neighbour, Crystal Whilby, 19, is also charged with the killing, but was not in court for this week's hearing.

Monday night's attack on the Alkham Road synagogue in Stoke Newington was the second on a Hackney synagogue in a fortnight.


They are investigating the possibliity that whoever is behind the phone calls is also behind the attack.
